Alliance Report- Steve Falkenberg and Terry Logging

- La Crosse will be the location of the 2023 fall workshops.
 - No county put in for the summer director meeting in July. We would be able to put in for this if we'd like.
- Both Bangor and the Ridge clubs are working on new trail segments.
- Some members feel we should be on the lookout for a lighter drag.
 - Steve provided state requirements needed for reimbursement, with the hope that any suggestions fall within the detailed guidelines.
- Steve made a request to Mary for half of our projected funding to cover early season expenses.
- Any signs needed from Linda need to be requested prior to December 10th, as she will be unavailable after that.
- The Alliance could put in to host the July or January AWSC meetings.
- Nancy is looking ahead to 2022 and wondering if the Alliance should continue with the calendar raffle.
 - She suggested that we could reduce the number of payouts, but increase the amount paid to winners.
 - Terry suggested the Alliance look into a golf outing for fundraising to possibly replace the calendar.
- There will be an ATV ride January 23rd, 2021, from Burr Oak to Mindoro, and from Mindoro to Stevenstown.
- The Alliance would appreciate it if anyone with knowledge of upcoming Snowmobile classes could pass the info to their reps. so that it can be posted on the Alliance website.
- Nancy mentioned that there was discussion at their clubs meeting regarding the possibility of the Alliance purchasing a boom style brush hog.
- There will be Pizza from Hunters at the next Alliance meeting: December 15th, at the Alliance building.

 - John had called Jason to tell him about it, but he wasn't able to clear it out yet.
- Trimming trees along Schneider's old farm on Jandt's should be done sometime this year if we can.
 - Chase Aleckson will help, if someone wants to put a crew together.
- Jason mowed their section of trail yesterday.
 - Terry moved that the club purchase a \$50.00 gift card to cover his fuel and expenses.
 - Rob seconded it.
 - The motion carried.
- Steve would like to put a new deck on the Kohlmeier bridge, as the boards continue to lift each year requiring regular maintenance.
 - He already repaired it this year.
 - The bottom layer should be fine, so we may be able to replace the top layer only.
 - We should wait for lumber prices to go down before we do this.
