Secretaries Report- Andy Meyer

Alliance Report- Steve Falkenberg and Terry Loging

- Only about 120 of the new miles approved for state funding have actually been approved.
 - The rest are awaiting some sort of clarification.
- They mentioned that we should consider adding the driver course back into the Snowmobile Safety Education.
- The AWSC Convention in Madison will have 5 buses with varying destinations for tours.
 - There will be no hospitality rooms this year, with a commons area instead.
 - The La Crosse Convention Bureau will enter a bid for a return of the convention to the La Crosse Area again.
- Linda provided samples of the new signs. They are very heavy, but well made.
- The LCSA trail system is composed of around 200 landowners.
- The front blade for the 2017 is finished and working well.
- The GPS tracking units are installed in the groomers.
 - 2 are working fine, one is so, and the other is in the process of getting on line.
 - The Groomer Tracking System by can be viewed via the GTS App on your phone.
- We had 2500 maps produced.
- The La Crosse County Highway Dept. will only be leasing 1 tractor for the '20-'21 Lease period.
- The Alliance elected to allow the Rockland Flooring company the rights to use our loading dock to load out materials from their recently purchased land surrounding the Alliance building.
- Steve would like to give the Alliance building a thorough cleaning while it is nearly empty.
- The Ridge Runners have a weekly poker run that is open to anyone, any Wednesday that the trails are open.
